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Dear Parents,

As summer approaches, thoughts of family time, sunshine and beaches fill our minds and warm our hearts. Your child has learned a great deal this year and is deserving of a nice break. At the same time, it is also imperative that each student continues some academic work over the summer so as to not lose the gains made in the classroom over the past academic year. In order to make summer work as productive and accessible as possible, we will be utilizing **two online platforms for all summer prep work and all login information will be provided by June 15**:

IXL - Your student's teacher will assign work to be completed over the course of the summer. This work will focus mostly on mathematics and can be completed any time over the summer from anywhere with internet access. **Each student must complete <u>all</u> work and score an 85% or higher. This will be the first grade in the first quarter gradebook.**

Accelerated Reader - Summer reading will be assigned using Accelerated Reader. Students will read books from their teacher's assigned reading list and complete their "reading practice tests" online. Each student earns points for successfully completing an assessment and must earn the designated amount of points by their teacher. Point totals vary depending on the length and difficulty of the book. Students who do not pass the assessment with 85% or above on their chosen book will not be allowed to retake the assessment to earn points. Rather, such students will be required to read another book at their level and complete that assessment with an 85% or above rather than retaking the previous one. This again will be included in the first quarter grade.

With these two online platforms in math and reading, there will be no need to print or fill out paper summer prep work, as all the assessments will be taken online. **These assessments will count as their first grades of the new school year.** It is our goal to use these engaging platforms to help students develop a joy for learning and continue to achieve academic growth throughout the summer. So, whether your students are grabbing a book to read by the pool or on the beach or are staying inside under the covers on a rainy day, we hope their love of reading will be a part of a wonderful summer vacation.
