STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Rosarian Academy is asking kindergarten through 8th grade students to be responsible for their everyday supplies. These supplies are separate from what the supply fee paid by some grade levels covers. That supply fee includes items such as online membership fees (IXL, Accelerated Reader, etc.), consumable workbooks, and communal classroom supplies.

Separately, the supplies that students will bring to class each day are for their personal use. Students are required to bring in the supplies listed for their grade level below and replenish throughout the year as necessary. Being prepared for class each day with the proper supplies is an opportunity for students to learn and improve upon their personal responsibility.

Students have two opportunities to bring in their supplies for the start of school:

- Meet the Teacher Day on Thursday, August 29 from 2:30 - 3:30 p.m. while setting up their lockers
- The First Day of School (September 4th for Lower School and September 3rd for Middle School)
